- Annual stipend

## **Funded Research Programs for Medical Students**

### **[UW MedStAR Program](#)**

University of Washington Medical Student Addiction Research Program. Focused on increasing access to addiction medicine care in rural Washington, Wyoming, Alaska, Montana and Idaho.

Provides:

- Addiction medicine mentorship
- Summer research training
- Clinical exposure
- Structured didactics
- NIH-supported programming
- Conference presentation opportunities
- \$5,000 stipend

### **[Wilson Scholars in Addiction Medicine Research Award](#)**

At University of Pittsburgh Department of Medicine.

An 8-week summer addiction medicine research program for medical students between M1 and M2. **Apply by early January.**

Includes:

- Mentored addiction research
- Clinical shadowing
- Structured didactics
- Systems/policy exposure
- Community addiction medicine experiences

### **[Scaife Medical Student Fellowship in Substance Use Disorders \(IRETA\)](#)**

A 3-week immersive addiction medicine training program for medical students with virtual learning and in-person clinical exposure in Pittsburgh.

- 1 week virtual + 2 weeks in-person (Pittsburgh)
- Provides a \$600 stipend plus housing and meals support
- Mix of lectures, clinical site visits, patient interaction, and recovery community exposure
- Includes addiction treatment centers, harm reduction organizations, inpatient/outpatient programs, and sometimes correctional settings

### **Physician Researchers in Training (PRiT) Program at Boston University**

**6–7 week funded summer addiction research program for medical students and other graduate-level trainees.**

- Full-time summer research project with a faculty mentor
- Weekly didactics (addiction science, harm reduction, policy, social determinants)
- Clinical exposure through observation in addiction treatment settings
  - Methadone clinics
  - Buprenorphine-based primary care programs
  - HIV/addiction care clinics
  - Needle exchange programs
  - Inpatient addiction consult services
- Skills gained:
  - Research design, data collection, analysis, and presentation
  - Exposure to addiction treatment systems and harm reduction care
  - Foundational understanding of substance use disorders and treatment approaches
- **Funding:** Supported by NIH/NIDA training grants (often includes stipend for participants)

### **Summer Institute for Medical Students (SIMS) Hazelden Betty Ford Foundation**

**A 5-day immersive program hosted by Hazelden Betty Ford Foundation in CA, OR, and MN**

- Gives medical students firsthand exposure to SUD treatment and recovery.
- Participants shadow patients and clinicians, attend group therapy sessions, and learn from leading experts in the field of SUD treatment, addiction medicine, and recovery.

### **FHE “Hope for Healing” scholarship**

- Up to \$5,000

- For students in mental health, behavioral health, psychiatry, nursing, or addiction medicine
- Requires 3.0 GPA + essay + U.S. residency
- Open to undergrad, graduate, and medical students

For American College of Medical Toxicology conference, focuses on:

- Overdose care
- Toxicology
- Withdrawal management
- Substance-related emergencies

Provides:

- Conference registration
